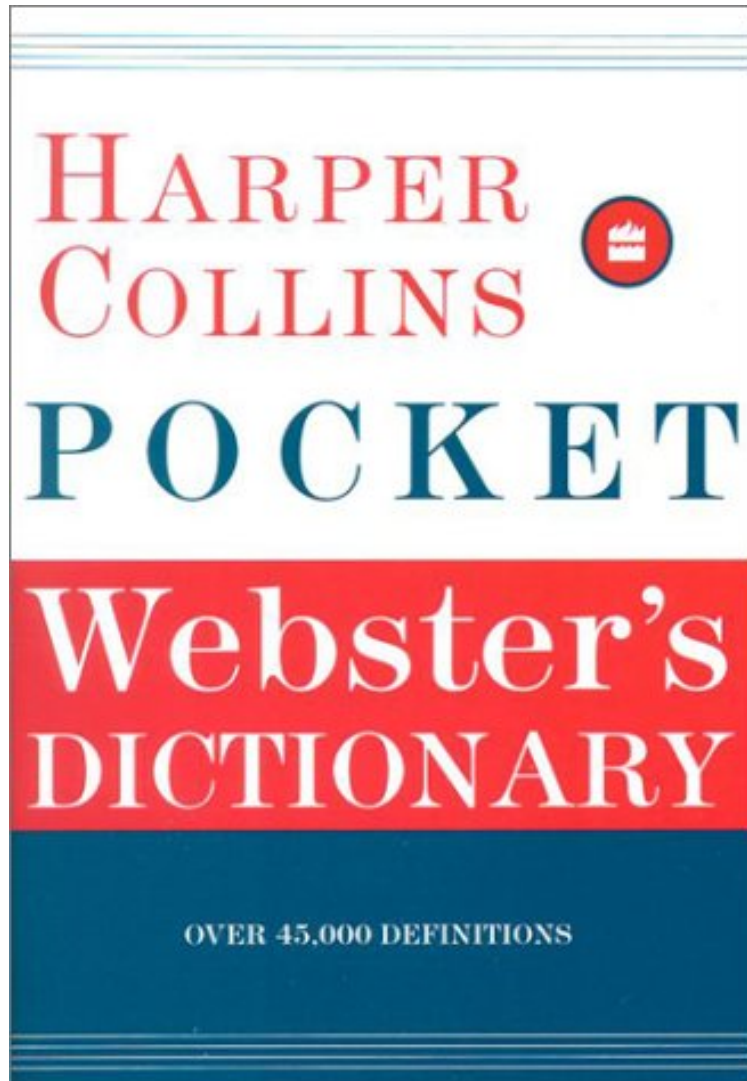

I know you're wondering why someone would bother to review a dictionary, but they're not all created equal! This little gem has heavier paper on the cover and inside, making it very sturdy to throw in your backpack. Also, the word itself is printed in bold blue, while the definition is printed in black, which is great if your eyesight is not all that great, or if you often need to find things quickly. It also passed the test in terms of having enough strange words.... the only things I need to look up are truly not used on a regular basis, so I gave it a few to see how many I could find - 3 out of 4, it turns out. (The words were "magniloquent", "shibboleth", "subaltern" and "solipsistic", in case you were wondering.) Anyway, I would recommend this for late high school or college age if you are buying this for yourself or your kid, and of course any adult would get some use out of it as well. for younger kids I think there are a large quantity of words they will never use, but maybe if you want a dictionary for them to grow into, this is it.
