There are 23 black and white illustrations.Chapter titles include "The Roots of May Day," "The First May Day and the Haymarket Affair," May Day--Watchword for Millions 1891-1914" up until last chapter, "1960 to the Eve of the Centennial" Foner's writing style is clear and to the point yet easy enough to follow.It looks like a very good book for anyone studying labor movements, May Day or American history.
